## **EHC: Two Clean Audits, Measurable Progress, Real Housing Impact**

Ekurhuleni Housing Company (EHC) Secures Second Consecutive Clean Audit

The Ekurhuleni Housing Company (EHC) is proud to announce that the Auditor-General's report, tabled today in Council by the Audit Committee, has confirmed that the entity has achieved a second consecutive clean audit. This achievement reflects EHC's unwavering commitment to good governance, accountability, and financial discipline.

This achievement is further cemented by the commitment of the City of Ekurhuleni (CoE) to support the delivery of affordable accommodation across the municipality.

Delivering the State of the City Address on 25 March 2026, Executive Mayor Ald. Xhakaza highlighted the City's ongoing efforts to expand access to quality, affordable housing.

Speaking on this milestone, the Executive Mayor commended Ekurhuleni Housing Company's (EHC) performance.

The entity confirms its commitment to maintain the delivery of performance and financial discipline. To date, the entity has improved collection from 21% In March 2025 to 43% In March 2026. EHC has reclaimed a total of 700 units of its rental stock, which had been hijacked. Through the evictions in Pharoe Park (August 2025) and Airport Park (Jan 2026), the units are now under the control and management of EHC.

EHC calls on the community of Ekurhuleni to apply for affordable accommodation in its complexes. EHC remains committed to building sustainable communities, strengthening partnerships, and ensuring that housing delivery continues to improve for the residents of Ekurhuleni.
